Pastor: According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

Congregation: God requires that his justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

Pastor: Can we make this payment ourselves?

Congregation: Certainly not. Actually, we increase our debt every day.

Pastor: *Can another creature—any at all—pay this debt for us?*

Congregation: No. To begin with, God will not punish any other creature for what a human is guilty of. Furthermore, no mere creature can bear the weight of God's eternal wrath against sin and deliver others from it.

Pastor: *What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?*

Congregation: One who is a true and righteous human, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God.
