We Confess Our Sins Together:

Father in heaven, we thank you for the freedom you have given us through the life, death and resurrection of your Son. But we confess today that we often live like slaves. Instead of living like you delight in us, we avoid you in shame and guilt. Instead of receiving your

favor as a gift, we try to earn it with our efforts. Instead of accepting your freedom, we prefer our chains. Instead of pursuing your purposes, we cling to our agendas. Forgive us. Embrace us. Cleanse us. Heal us. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.

Pastor: Since we have been delivered from our misery by grace through Christ without any merit of our own, why then should we do good works?

Pastor: Can those be saved who do not turn to God from their ungrateful and unrepentant ways?

All: By no means. Scripture tells us that no unchaste person, no idolater, adulterer, thief, no covetous person, no drunkard, slanderer, robber, or the like will inherit the kingdom of God.

Pastor: What is involved in genuine repentance or conversion?

Congregation: Two things: the dying-away of the old self, and the rising-to-life of the new.
