God Assures Us We Are Forgiven: Romans 8:1-2

* We Confess Our Faith Together: Heidelberg Catechism Questions #45-47

Pastor: How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?

Congregation: First, by His resurrection He has overcome death, so that He could make us share in the righteousness which He had obtained for us by His death. Second, by His power we too are raised up to a new life. Third, Christ's resurrection is to us a sure pledge of our glorious resurrection.

Pastor: What do you confess when you say, He ascended into heaven?

Congregation: That Christ, before the eyes of His disciples, was taken up from the earth into heaven, and that He is there for our benefit until He comes again to judge the living and the dead.

Pastor: Is Christ, then, not with us until the end of the world, as He has promised us?

Congregation: Christ is true man and true God. With respect to His human nature He is no longer on earth but with respect to His divinity, majesty, grace, and Spirit He is never absent from us.
