Sermon Outline Exodus 3:13-22 "When God Declared to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"

Proposition: God declares of Himself to Moses "I AM WHO I AM" so that all Israel would know the essence of God in His person, promise, and power to deliver them.

Main Point One: The Person of God
