Sermon Outline Exodus 5:1-6:1 "Pharaoh's Mockery of God and His People, Israel" 09-18-22

Proposition: Sinful man's mockery of God and His people reveals the true nature of a hardened heart in the arrogance of sin making one ripe for the judgment of God.
