Sermon Outline Exodus 12:1-11 "The Institution of the Lord's Passover" 10-16-22

Proposition: The Lord's Passover is a sign of God's judgment against recalcitrant Pharaoh in Egypt and Divine deliverance for those households covered in the blood of the lamb.
