Ezekiel 37:15-28

<u>Big Idea:</u> Since God has promised to unify His people through purification, we must detach ourselves from things that defile us.

Main Point #1: The Promise

What has God promised?

Main Point #2: The Means

How will God accomplish what He has promised?

He will bring them back to the land

He will install one king over them

He will purify their remaining sin
